
FITTING OF WHEEL SPATS – INSTRUCTIONS

SPRING CLIP

TRIAL FITTING/MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS (prior to painting)

- 1. Jack up the vehicle, insert jack stands under vehicle, and remove rear wheels.
- 2. Remove the rubber from the wheel spats.
- 3. Place front mount behind the wheel arch lip on the inside of the inner wheel arch.
- 4. Stretch spring clip over the rear inner wheel arch and release spring.
- 5. Hold spat tight against the wheel arch with one hand and with the other hand bend the locator tabs up to hold the spat into place. This should create a tight fit against the wheel arch.
- 6. Remove the wheel spats and refit the wheels.
- 7. Your spats are ready for prepare and paint.
- 8. Once spats are painted secure rubber to wheel spats with either trim adhesive or urethane based product (eg. Sikaflex).
- 9. Repeat steps 3,4
- 10. If you follow these instructions correctly the wheel spats will remain on your car it is optional to put a small screw in the rear of the wheel spat into the wheel arch, under the rubber, to prevent someone stealing them.
